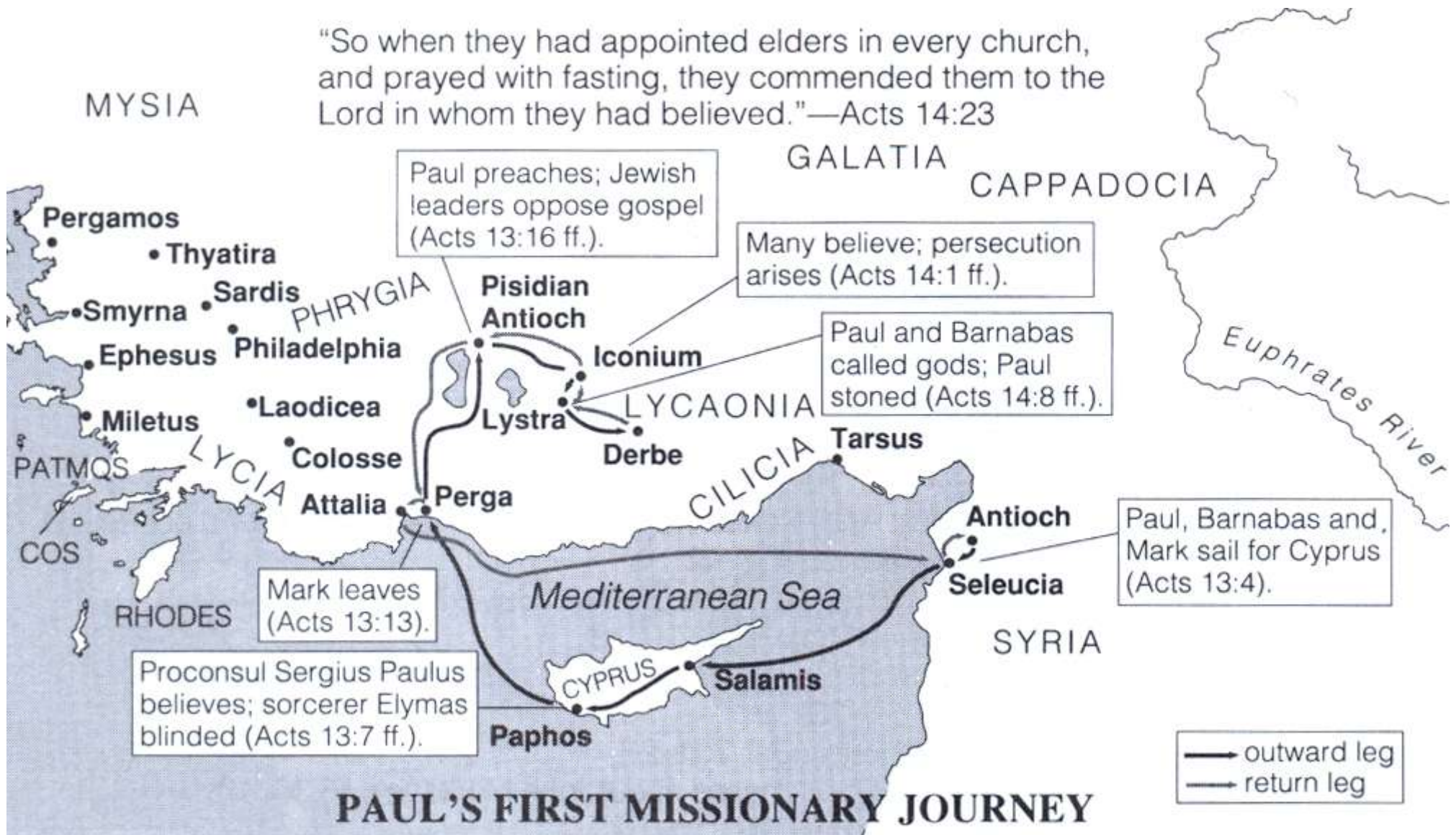


De zendingsreizen van Paulus

Many believe; persecution arises (Acts 14:1 ff.).

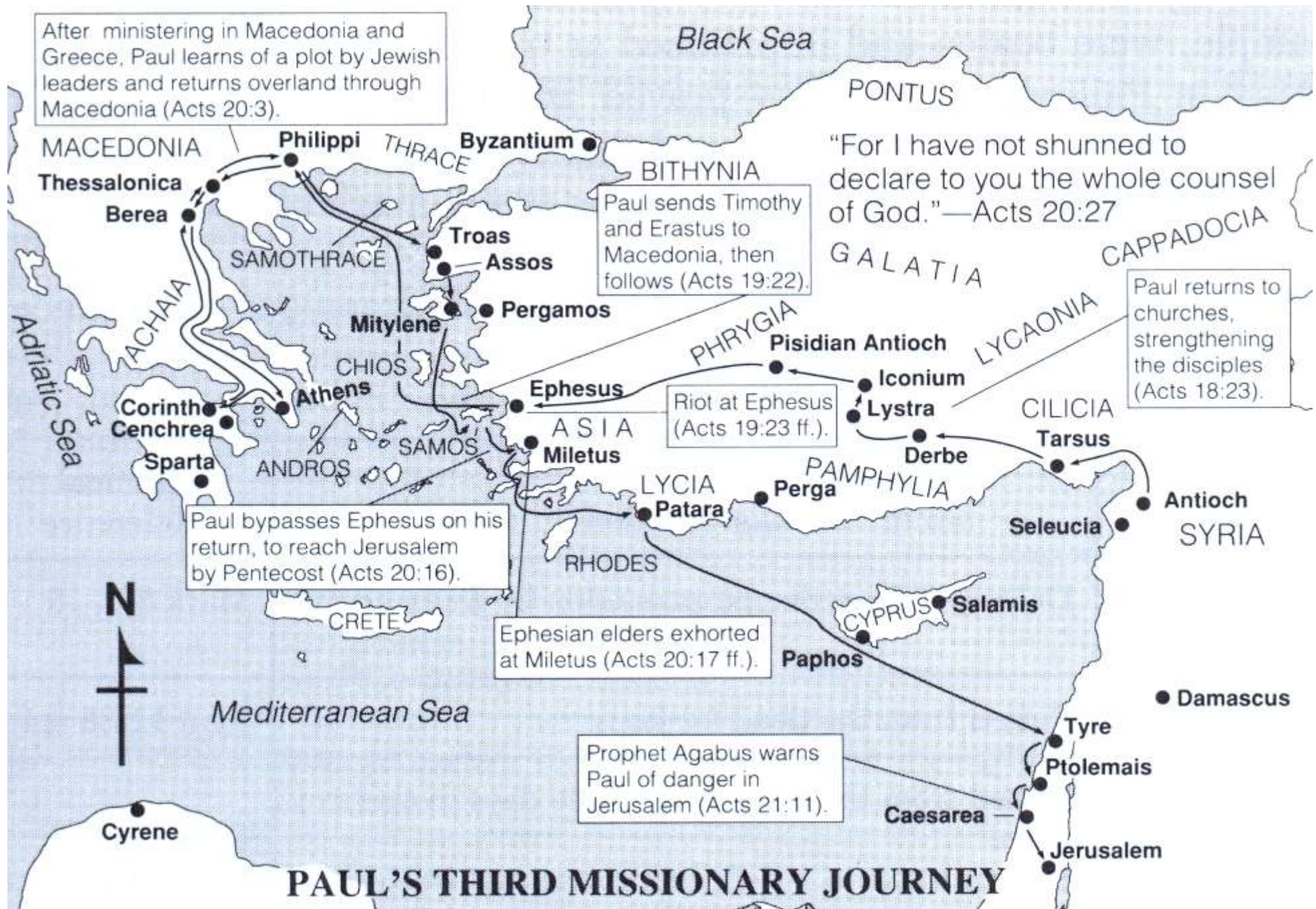
Paul and Barnabas called gods; Paul stoned (Acts 14:8 ff.).

Paul, Barnabas and Mark sail for Cyprus (Acts 13:4).

Mark leaves (Acts 13:13).

Proconsul Sergius Paulus believes; sorcerer Elymas blinded (Acts 13:7 ff.).

Paul, under guard, dwells in rented house in Rome (Acts 28:16,30).

Brethren welcome Paul (Acts 28:14).

Shipwrecked on Malta; stays three months (Acts 27:41 ff.).

Ship driven by tempest for many days (Acts 27:20).

Head wind blows ship off course (Acts 27:14).

Paul is transferred to an Alexandrian ship bound for Italy (Acts 27:6).

Julius the centurion puts Paul aboard a ship of Adramyttium (Acts 27:2).
